**Grand Auction for the Children's and Ching Ming Days**

**Acquiring More than NT\$533.3 Million of Auction Amount for the National Treasury**

The Branches of the Administrative Enforcement Agency of the Ministry of Justice held a nationwide joint auction held on the “first” “Tuesday” of every month, starting at “3” p.m. On April 2, in which various popular items were successfully sold out and the total auction amount reached NT\$503,300,305, which has all been contributed to the national treasury.

The total auction amount for real estate reached NT\$499,817,926. The auction with the highest amount and attracted the most attention was the auction by the Taichung Branch, which reached an amount of NT\$442,568,888 by auctioning the 4-star “Grand City Hotel” located in front of Fengyuan Train Station in Taichung City. The hotel is located on Section 1 of Sanfeng Road, Fengyuan District, right next to the train station, which was renovated by the consortium with a budget of NT\$700 million from the old “Pro Kennex Hotel.” The whole building had 12 floors and 120 rooms. In addition to providing accommodation, it also featured Chinese and Western restaurants, a gym, a SPA center, etc., making it the only 4-star hotel within Fengyuan District. In addition, the Yilan Branch auctioned two plots of cemetery land located in Jinshan District, New Taipei City for more than NT\$23.95 million. Since the auction items were not easy to sell in the auction market and many previous auctions by the court ended in failure, the Yilan Branch took the initiative to notify the funeral directors near the auction items for proper publication of the auction this time, the

items were auctioned successfully. Furthermore, the Changhua Branch also sold a house in Shetou Township, Changhua County at a high auction price of NT\$26,209,999. Other branches also auctioned various real properties in good conditions and ended the conclusion of the auction with exceptional results.

The total amount of property auctioned reached NT\$3,482,379. The Changhua Branch held the “Bagua Mountain Foreclosure Market,” which featured diverse and affordable auction items. As soon as the auction began, it attracted a large number of visitors to make their bids and the total auction amount reached NT\$192,990. In addition, in order to celebrate the upcoming Children's Day, the Branch organized the “Children Painting Coloring Contest” to allow kids to celebrate Children's Day early, which would not only enhance parent-child interaction, but also spread the nowhere-but-anywhere “law compliance” function of administrative enforcement. The Kaohsiung Branch auctioned a Tesla EV manufactured in 2022 at an affordable price of NT\$1.1 million. Other properties auctioned by the other Branches include computer peripherals, multiple cars and motorcycles, liquor, wood carvings, physical stock certificates, etc.
